

Q. David Bowers is an American numismatist. Beginning in 1952, Bowers's contributions to

numismatics have continued uninterrupted and unabated to the present day. He has been involved in the selling of rare coins since 1953 when he was a teenager. A 1960 graduate of the Pennsylvania State University, Q. David Bowers was given the Alumni Achievement Award by that institution's College of Business Administration. --This text refers to an alternate Hardcover edition.

Great book, invaluable amount of data and history, first rate research on a subject where it is difficult to find any information. I own the first seven volumes and use them regularly prior to purchasing any banknotes. The problem, and the reason for the one star rating, is the incredibly weak binding. I ordered two books from different sellers and had to return both of them because they were literally falling out of the bindings before I could remove them from the package; one text I did not even open. On the first text I ordered the inside page was separating from the cover; on the other there was a two inch crack running up the outside of the spine and the pages were already separating. If you buy this volume, you should also purchase a three ring binder to place the pages in. A pity such a monumental work in this field has been placed in the cheapest binding Whitman could find. I have seen paperbacks with better bindings. We contacted the company and they offered to replace it with a "selected" one at a higher price than I could find it on ... You decide...
