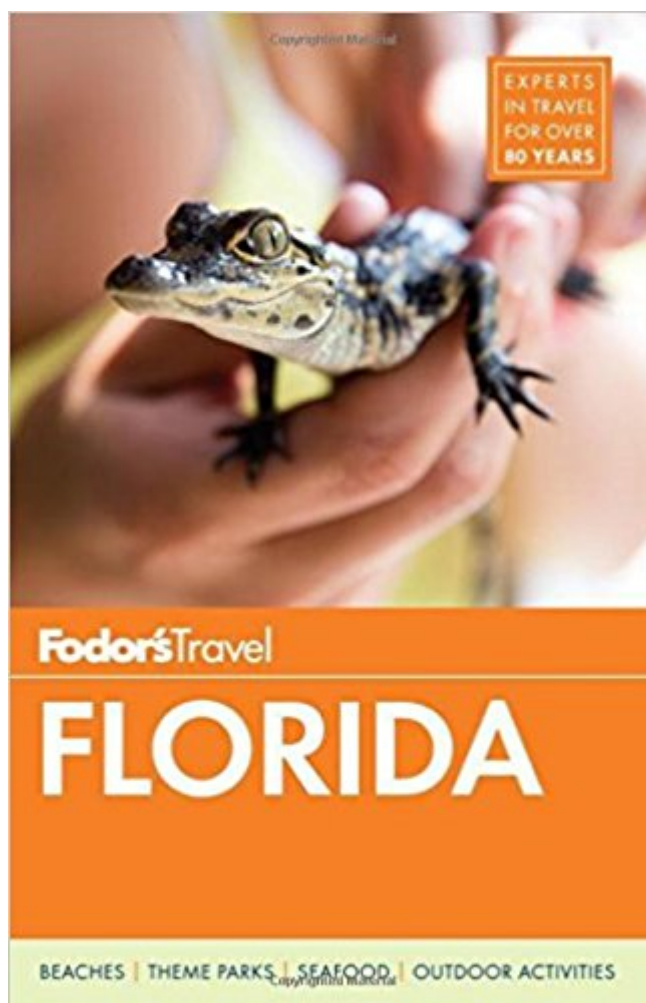

This book is absolutely packed with information about Florida, and places to see. I'm kind of surprised that in the index nothing is listed about "camping". Not that I want to drive all the way to Florida to go camping, but I know there has to be campsites in Florida for those who'd rather camp instead of staying in hotels. Also, last summer we went to St. Augustine, Florida and toured the "Castillo de San Marcos" so I am very familiar with that fort, visiting it many times from childhood to middle-age. St. Augustine is listed in the index, but when I go to the page indicated about the Castillo de San Marcos fort, it shows a different fort. I can't remember the name of that particular fort, but it's down the river from the Castillo de San Marcos, and is a LOT smaller. We visited it too, while there. It's just a little weird that such a large, and historically important fort is mixed up with a tiny fort. All that said, I still think this is a good book just to have mainly as a reference since most everything you will want to know about Florida is easily found on the internet. It's a good book to take and read on the way to Florida, especially if you're driving. Since you can "See Inside" I won't go into listing a bunch of stuff contained in this book. It has a pull-out map of Florida in the very back of the book but of course I managed to rip it trying to pull it out. And now I can't get it folded back in so good luck using that. It's a Florida travel book so you already know what to expect from it.

I have travelled most of the state of Florida and visited most parts of it and done so many times. This book is a good review of the regions, where to stay, what to do, where to dine, etc. I like the "exploring" topics that highlight activities and attractions of the areas. The restaurants chosen are good ones, and they highlight "Fodor's Choice," of the author's favorites. There is a section in the beginning of "great itineraries" that has good ways of visiting different sections of the state of Florida. Great book for planning a Florida vacation. I didn't like the cover; a collage of photos of Florida, since it is beaches to space rockets, to amusement parks, to night life, to culture etc. would have been better. I realize my opinion is subjective, however a photo of baby alligator in someone's hand really doesn't appeal to me.
