

His years of experience include providing photographs and leading backcountry paddling trips for many environmental organizations, including National Geographic, The Nature Conservancy, and World Wildlife Fund. He lives in Big Pine Key, Florida.

There have been at least four books written in the past decade about paddling in the Keys. All are

worth a read. What I find remarkable about Bill's book is he found his own niche by heavy coverage of the floral, fauna and marine life that paddlers can see if they pay attention to their surroundings. He is not the first to do so. Bruce Wachob another Florida Keys kayak guide SEA KAYAKING IN THE FLORIDA KEYS (1997) started the tide rolling in that direction.. Kathy Patton, KAYAKING THE KEYS, 2002 , covers it to a lesser extent and does a fine job on the lower keys... Bill Keogh's book covers all of this plus the best put in's and trips in the upper, middle and lower keys. From Mile post 125 to Mile Post 1 and is a must for anyone even half seriously contemplating paddling these waters. WARNING You cannot paddle the keys by driving down U.S. 1 and looking for places to put-in. Most of those are way off the beaten automotive track . Winds and tides are a real puzzle for visitors and even native guides. Bill's book will set you on the proper course for a good paddling experience.

We took this book with us for a paddling trip in the Florida Keys. The book definitely needs to be updated. We couldn't do some of the day trips we wanted to because the put-in sites listed in the guide were no longer available -- blocked by locked gates. When I ordered the book, I didn't realize that the publication date of the "all-new guide to sea kayaking trips" was 2004! Good descriptions of what you might see on each outing -- if you can get out on the water.

Great guide with a lot of details on places to stop in the Keys!! Looking forward to checking out spots next week!!!
