You will get requests for many more of these dresses in all sorts of colors. Best thing is, every color you make these in, makes the dress look like an entirely different dress! 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Customer Reviews

This pattern says to use size #8 needles and knitting worsted (size 4 yarn), but does not provide a gauge (number of stitches and rows per inch). A knitting pattern should ***always*** provide a gauge, so one star off right off the bat for that omission. I made up the white dress according to the pattern, using #8 needles with size 4 yarn, and the dress is way too big. The doll's waist is about 12", while the waist of the dress measures about 20". The dress is very cute, but the fit is way off. I have knitted up other doll dresses by this and other designers, and know that my knitting gauge typically matches the yarn size and needles recommended, so I have concluded that the #8 needle recommendation is a typo. #6 needles would have been much better. The second star is deducted for the mistake on knitting needle size. Had the designer simply included a gauge in the pattern, the mistake on needle size would have been caught right away. Too bad, because the dresses are very cute.

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
