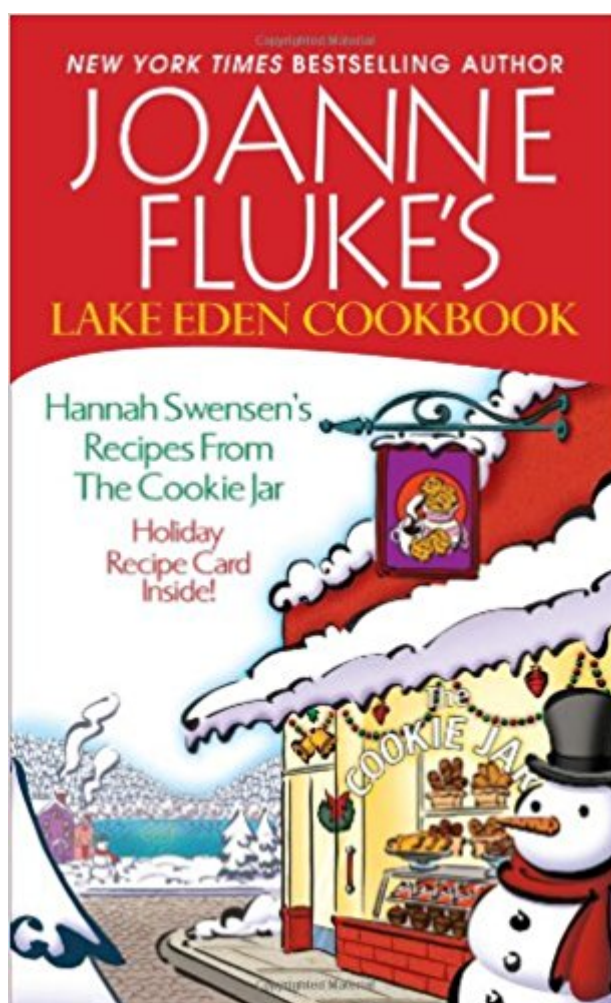

I love the cookbook idea. I have really wanted a book that had all the recipes in one place. My only complaint is it is not in a cookbook form. It is more like story that has recipes mixed in here and there. I would have loved a lot more if it was more like a regular cookbook.

Finally, I can get rid of the copies of the recipes I made from the books in this delightful series. Now I have ALL the recipes from each book (except the latest two) not just the ones I chose on first reading the books. If there is any drawback to the recipes, it is the rather overly chatty format, incorporating the characters "opinions" into the directions. At least having them in one book is better than having to copy extra sheets because the commentary often made the recipes several pages in length. Having tried many of the recipes, I'd recommend them to anyone but the most novice baker. Be advised, the cookies make large batches, but are easy to scale back with no detriment to the final product.

I like the mystery books written by this author. I have audible - I listened to a half dozen of books written by Joanne Fluke and this cookbook is featured in her mystery books. The recipes are basic, but is nice to have them all in one book. The only problem I have with this product is that I wish it was laid out in cookbook form; as in, if it was larger and perhaps would lay better. I have the Mass Market Paperback version which is very difficult to read and refer to when in the kitchen.

I like this series. The characters are lovable. The books are light hearted, fun, and I love the recipes. It is always fun to read the book and cook the recipe that accompanies it.

Joanne Fluke's Lake Eden Cookbook is short on story but long on recipes. It has all the recipes from the first eight or nine Hannah Swenson books with a little bit of a story thrown in to make it interesting. I am working my way through most of her cookie recipes so it is nice to have them in one place. Even if you are not a murder/mystery buff like myself this little cookbook is delightful. And it is not just cookie recipes. There are several casserole dishes included but in Minnesota they are called Hot Dishes.

This review format doesn't allow for something as unusual as a cookbook that is more than just a collection of recipes. It was 'predictable' in that there is a story line and the usual characters make their appearances -- but I chose to say it had 'twists' because of the recipes, which are the purpose of the book. It was definitely a fun read -- and a lot more convenient to have recipes in one spot instead of skipping around in her books!
