

## Synopsis

Twin authors Aron and Gabriel Lesser, 24 year-old Brazilian-Americans, believe that São Paulo has become an exciting tourist hotspot, especially for those on a budget. The guide is divided into three parts: food, walking tours, and nightlife. Section I is a mini-history lesson about the relationship between food and identity in São Paulo, and provides great and inexpensive food suggestions. Section II re-imagines São Paulo's downtown as ten walkable pieces • based on cultural spaces rather than traditional neighborhood boundaries. Unlike conventional walking tours, the pieces • have no starting and ending points. Instead, the twins encourage travelers to explore the city with a greater degree of independence. Section III focuses on São Paulo's world-renowned nightlife, as the authors give readers a cultural tour of the city's bars, nightclubs, and live music venues. For Aron and Gabriel, youth • is a mentality not an age. Their goal for Piecing Together São Paulo is to transform how travelers approach urban tourism in cosmopolitan and globalized cities like São Paulo.

So let's start off here by acknowledging that Sao Paulo is not an easy city to navigate. The streets are windy and congested, the high rises seemingly never end, and as a tourist it's really hard to know what's worth your time (especially if your time is limited). I purchased this guide, one of the few English language guides I could find that featured the type of "hip"/not-overly-touristic places that I like, and was thrilled! The walking tour aspect of it feels unique and helps you to garner a cohesive perspective on each neighborhood's individual charm. The places the authors recommend truly have something special to offer beyond your run-of-the-mill spots that these guides usually recommend to give readers a "Brazilian experience." So yeah, this guide comes 100% recommended. Plus, I was doing some snooping in a cab ride while in Sao Paulo and discovered that the authors are in fact twins! This really got me extra excited. But anyways, if you like cool hidden spots, great food and relevant but not boring historic sites (and twins!)--this book is for you. Also it's really not that expensive so if you're on the fence, ask yourself if you'll actually ever miss your \$3-4. (You won't.)

Such a fun guide to have while exploring the city! At their worst, travel guides can be overwhelming with their options. Or, they make you feel like you're walking through a city just to check off a bunch of boxes. This guide was clearly written out of genuine love for São Paulo, and it shows! Instead of a broad overview of the city, this guide gives you a small but rich window into what makes it a special place to visit. The guide is also easy to carry and use. It's small, but full of colorful and easy to read maps. There's a diversity of recommendations for good food, art, and history. I particularly enjoyed the section about Liberdade, São Paulo's Japantown. You really get the sense that the neighborhood is a dynamic, living part of the city, not just a tourist trap.

Before traveling I often have trouble deciding between spending \$30 on a Lonely Planet Guide or \$0 sifting through online blogs. To be honest neither option gives me what I'm looking for, and either provides too much or too little, so I decided to try this guide book, and it is EVERYTHING I could have hoped for from a travel guide book!! The authors clearly know their city well, and even better, know their money-saving audience! Plus, I really enjoyed all of the jokes they included in the book -- it kept me smiling the whole way through :) I hope they write guides for more cities in the future!

Cute graphics, fun style and great recommendations for bars, food, activities and all types of hidden gems. I loved that the authors included notes on history and culture that I hadn't found in other
