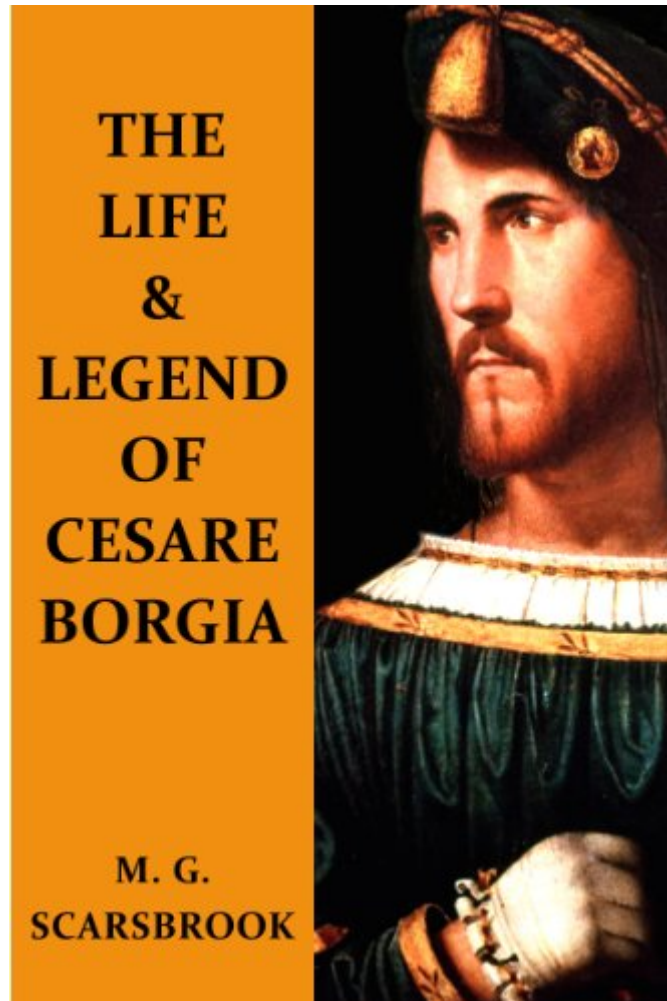




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The Life & Legend Of Cesare Borgia

This book is informative. Straightforward historical events in chronological order under several categorical headings. Not for entertainment, just information. Historical novels like Sara Poole's series, Sarah Bower's Sins of the House of Borgia, and M.G. Scarsbrook's works are for entertainment, information, and literary speculation about these fascinating Machiavellians and their relationships.

Although it's important to put history in the perspective of the time it occurred, Scarsbrook goes overboard. He refutes most of the "legendary" Borgia history and defends the rest by saying that "everybody else did it too" (simony, licentiousness, etc.). And while that is probably true, he repeats this over and over. There are several sections in the book besides the piece by Scarsbrook (including The Prince) and one of the other pieces discusses all the stories that we've heard about the Borgias. So I feel left without any information. Also, the Kindle edition has a lot of typos.
