

Richardâ ™s love for family and nature overflows into his illustrations which are enjoyed by children around the world. The artist and his wife live in Ohio and have four grown children and five grandchildren.

I liked it. But - it's not an absolute MUST READ. Most of Anthony DeStefano's books are books children should not live without. I LOVE his books and his writing style. This one is good - but it's just not in the same category as his others. The Donkey No One Could Ride and The Lamb books are books every child should have, though.

I bought this book for our granddaughter because the puppy looked like our dog, and the story was sweet. The part where the puppy gathers up a ton of food and gives every bit to the other dogs while he continues to starve was a little over-the-top, but small children might not object to the super-good (or extremely low-self-esteem) doggie character. We also bought "The Sheep That No One Could Find," by the same author, which had a Scripture and a spiritual application at the end, and thought this book might have concluded with a Scripture, too. The story of the puppy's finding a home with Jesus begged for (no pun intended) a Scripture for the children to see themselves as finding a "home" with Him, as well.

This book was purchased to add to a small library for children's religious classes. I love it, and the individual teachers who used it, were very happy. Their classes enjoyed and learned from it's story.
