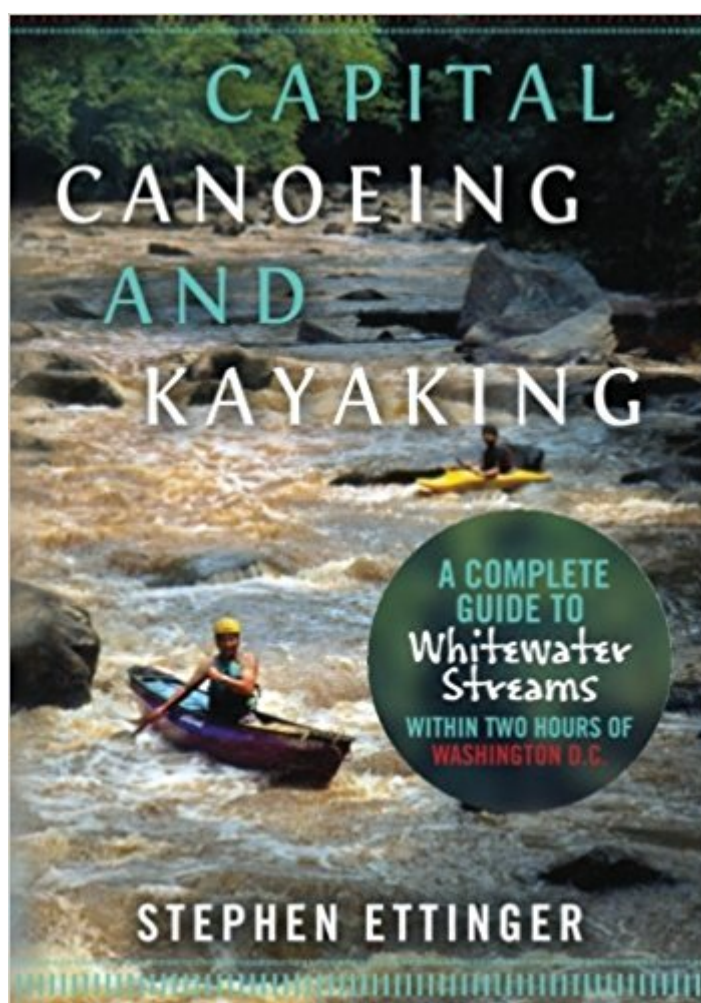

This book describes in detail and from personal experience 372 whitewater creeks within 2 hours of Washington DC. It is extremely useful. Some of my paddling buddies and I were looking for a new adventure after a heavy rain. We tried one of the little known creeks recommended in the book. We had a ball. The description in the book was completely accurate. The book is also entertaining to read. In describing one of the streams, the author searches for something good to say about his experience paddling the stream. He finally identifies one--since he paddled it alone, he did not lose any friends by dragging them along on such a miserable experience. The book is as useful as a source of advice about creeks that are not worth paddling as it is about creeks that are fun to paddle.

This book is a great and detailed guide to canoe and kayak rivers and streams within reasonable distance of the Baltimore/Washington Metro area. Descriptions of water trails are detailed and rather

exhaustive. This book is a great update and compliment to Gertler's "Maryland & Delaware Canoe Trails". Both should be included any paddler's inventory both include water trip descriptions from novice to expert. Book was delivered as promised and in condition described.

Besides being a practical guide to when, where, and how to navigate whitewater streams within two hours of D. C., the book contains details of the surrounding countryside, interesting history of the areas, personal experiences of the author and others, and tongue-in-check shots at Washington politics.

The author covers rivers, streams, and ditches that are not covered by other river reference books. His personality is inserted with humor and detail. He is a wonderful person and this book reflects his many years of exploration and enthusiasm for the sport.
