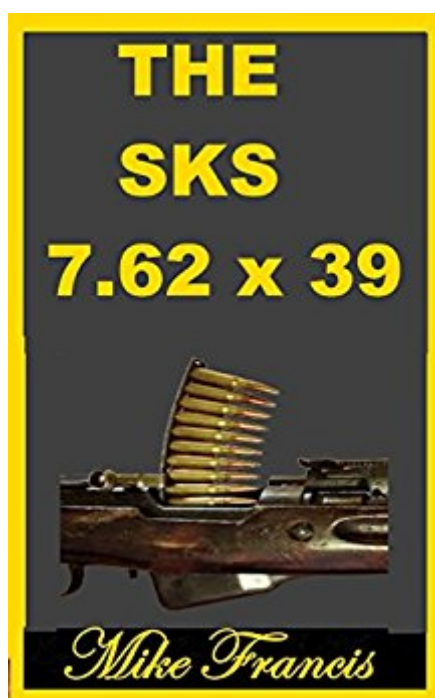




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The SKS 7.62 X 39: The Soviet M1 Carbine, And Predecessor To The AK-47
