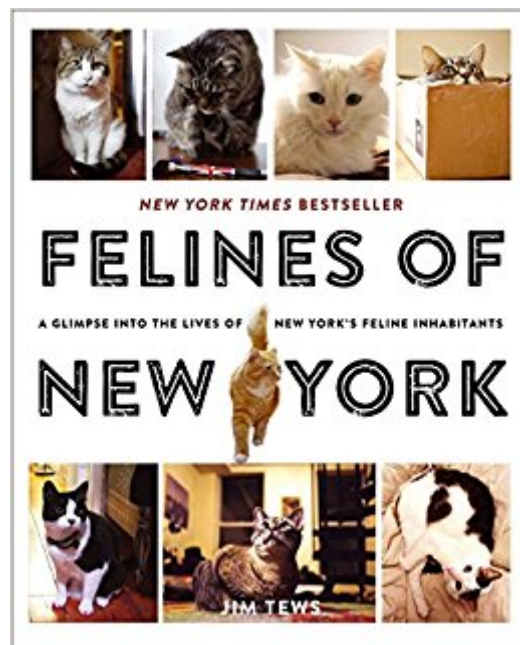




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Felines Of New York: A Glimpse Into The Lives Of New York's Feline Inhabitants
