

I have never seen such stunning pictures of Mayans and Incas of South America. The text is, however, lagging behind, it is a little bit too simple, especially for the 4th graders. This is basically not the quality of text you want to see. There is simply not enough information - just a couple of sentences. I have read this book free.

If you have read or downloaded other Baby Professor books then you know exactly what to expect from them. The books themselves are not very long (about 18 pages) with well written facts accompanied by amazing pictures. As with all Baby Professor books the books really take the cake and help to keep young children engaged in the book. My son is only four and has not yet entered public school but we do learning activities at home everyday and this book is just one of many that we have read when learning about history. The book comes in handy in so many different lesson plans from learning about South America, to learning about the Incas and Mayans. This is a book that we will be able to use again and again.
