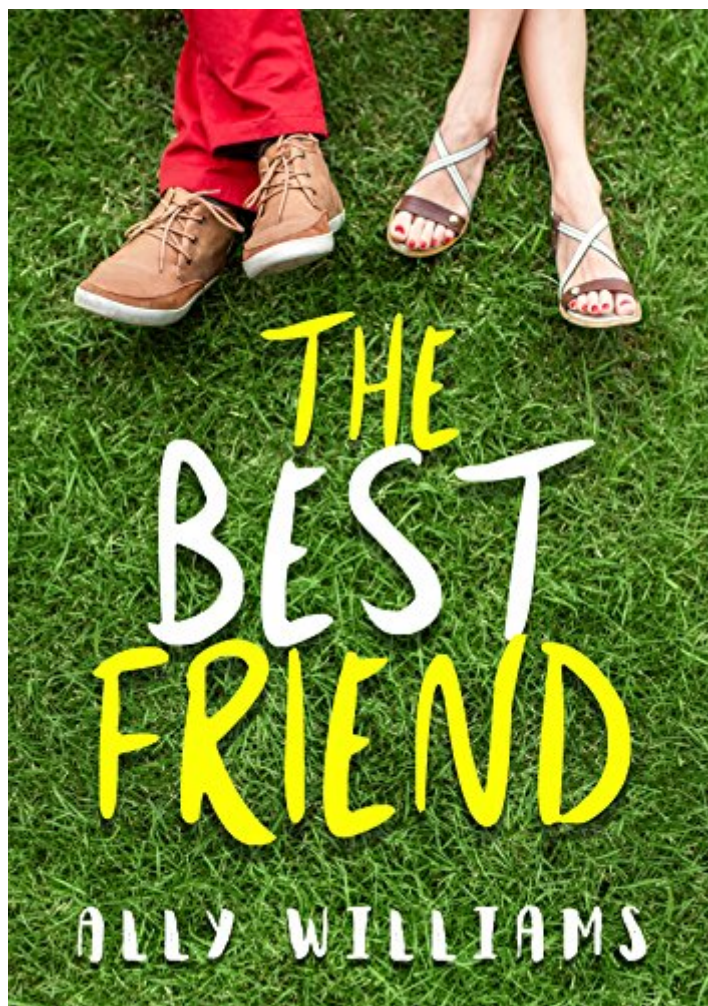




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The Best Friend: A Young Adult Romance Story

There were some ups and downs with this book, but mostly ups for me. I found the story to be perfectly heartbreaking. I would suggest that if you are faint of heart, this would not be for you, but if you enjoy that like I do, go for it! Ally Williams has a great writing style. I have a love-hate feeling for Hayden, but he is still a good character. The open-ending has me a little off. I prefer a complete

HEA or at least knowledge of a coming follow-up. Nothing wrong with an open-ending, it works in some cases, but I'm not sure if it does here. I was provided with a complimentary copy of this book, through Reading Deals, so I could give an honest review.
