Being botanically challenged, I was looking for a general guide to the flowers all around me. This book titled "Familiar Flowers of North America" seemed perfect. However, after receiving it, I realized that it only covered the eastern part of the country and only wild flowers. The eastern limitation was noted only in the picture of the cover of the item, nowhere in print in the product description. The "wildflower only" aspect is mentioned nowhere at all. You learn that only when you get the book. It appears adequate for what it covers, but it is not what is advertised. It does not meet my needs.
