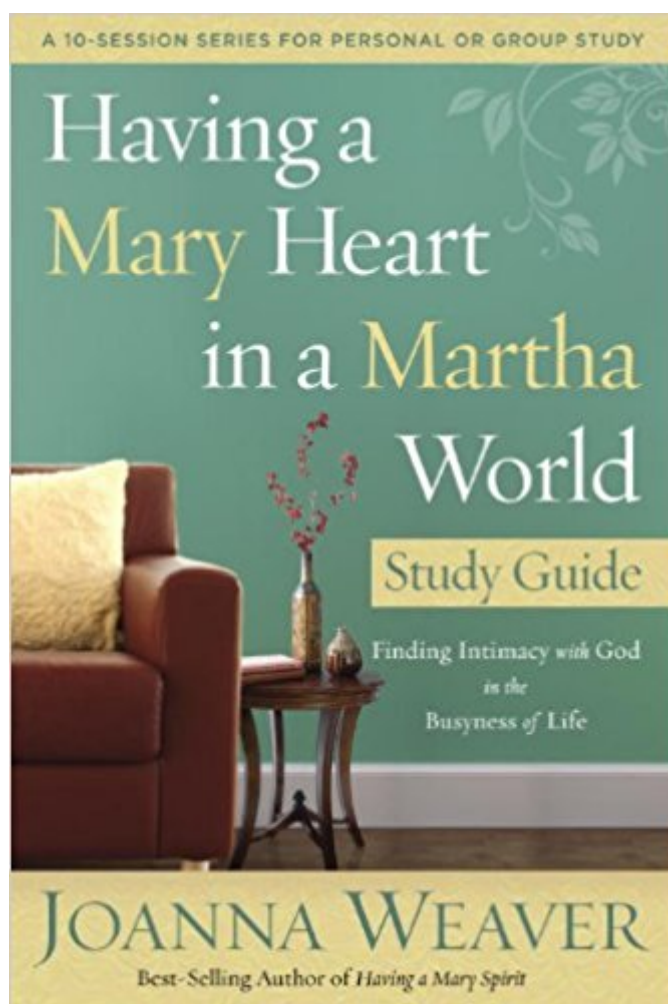

Our Bible study group found this study after an internet search. We were unfamiliar with the author, but after previewing several studies we decided to give it a try. We were happy with the format of a short (20 minute) video and study questions for each meeting. We appreciated the questions and research of Bible verses, reassuring us that our conclusions were based on the Bible. There was a good mixture of direct questions and open ended discussion questions. We found the study very relevant to our daily lives. Her illustrations and stories gave us insight into methods of keeping ourselves balanced between our Martha and Mary roles. I especially liked her suggestions for prayer and devotion time, making it more meaningful and fitting it into a busy schedule. All of us would recommend this study to others, no matter what their age or situation.

As for the book it is somewhat useful of course if you are studying the main book. However, there is a version of the main book available that has the Study Guide already in it.
