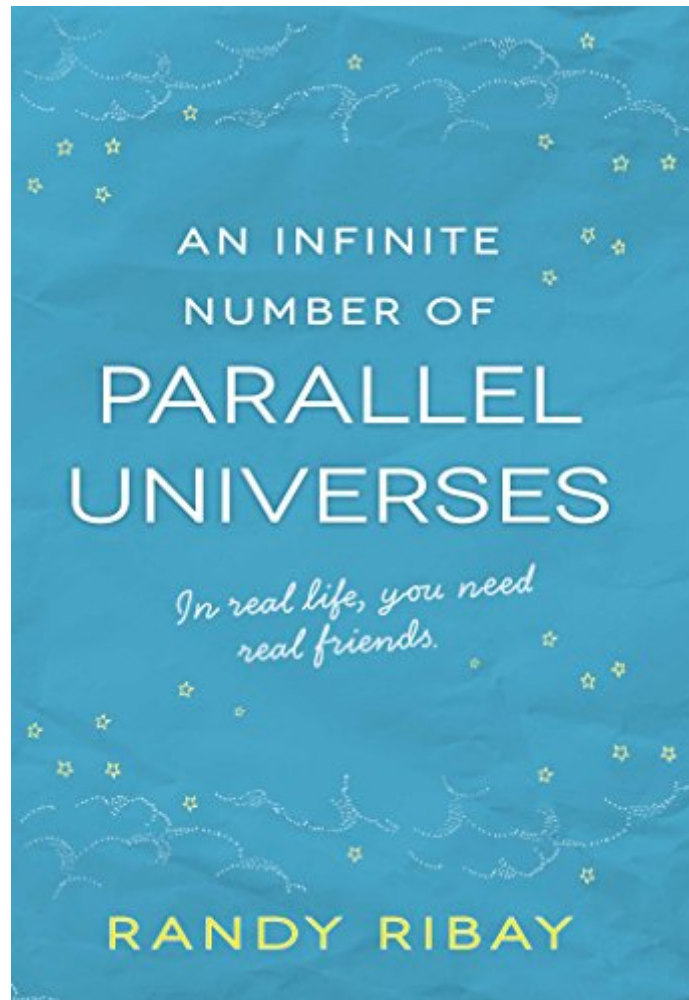

playing Dungeons & Dragons once a week, deepens and strengthens as each faces new adult personal problems: coming out as gay, dealing with a divorce, facing the prospect of meeting a birth mother. Very heartfelt, culminating in a road trip that marks their entry into a more grown-up world.
