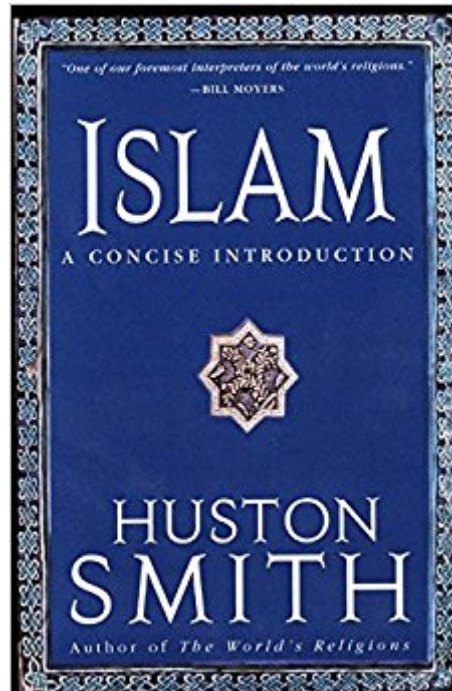

This is an excellent primer for anyone who wants to learn about Islam, a religion that is so feared by many in the West. Huston Smith, a great teacher of world religions, paints a picture of the beauty of Islam and what it has offered the world, shedding light on how this religion was a beacon of light in the world while Europeans were wallowing in the mud of the Dark Ages. He points out as well how Islam (meaning Peace) is no different than any other religion, in that it too has been hijacked by nationalism, fundamentalism and schisms. What I particularly found enlightening were the chapters on Sufism, the esoteric aspect of Islam. In reading the tenets of this mystical practice, I said to my wife, "Hey, I'm a Sufi!"
