

This book (coffee table size) contains wonderful, detailed photographs of about 40 rural churches from across the United States, each incredibly beautiful in its own way--some very simple, such as Missionary Baptist in Cades Cove, Tennessee (one of my favorite places in the south); others more formal, such as St. James Episcopal in Goose Creek, SC. Very interesting and easily readable information is included by the historian author, as well as close-up pictures of settings, interiors, windows, and historical items. I'm extremely happy with this book! My only complaint is that the sticker with the price was hard to remove from the back of the one I received.

I usually don't buy large coffee table books, but I made an exception for this one and I'm glad I did. I love the beautiful photos of the old, historic churches. I think churches are sacred spaces where you truly feel the presence of God and this book reflects that. I like the story and history that goes along with the photos. This is a lovely book and I enjoy looking/reading through it. The church on the cover is actually in Alabama, which I enjoyed because that is where I am originally from. The Southern churches and New England churches are my very favorite.
