Artist, designer and teacher Judith Katz takes readers on a journey of discovery that's equal parts history, art, literature and folklore in *A Painter's Guide to the Catskills of Rip Van Winkle*. This lovely and lyrical artist's notebook depicts 13 of Katz's favorite "magic places" in the eastern rim of the Catskill Mountains, the land of James Fenimore Cooper's Leatherstocking stories and the site of the Hudson River School of Painting. Katz shares personal observations, local legends and historical facts about the area's Victorian villages, valleys, waterfalls, roads, vistas, inns and farmhouses. Each site is accompanied by her colorful impressionistic renderings and a map. Besides creating striking paintings, she is also a skilled writer whose love and awe for this region is effectively communicated to the reader. For example, she describes the bottom of the Kaaterskills Falls in this way: "Hidden here in the cleft of the mountain I saw, like a child's fantasy, this ribbon of water falling out of the sky, as it ran past me for a moment on its way to the Hudson, on its way to the ocean - to

become a cloud, to become rain, to become, perhaps, part of a person. To travel those inner streams, to return once again, perhaps, to this place." Katz's book is a terrific souvenir for those familiar with the area, and the uninitiated will feel as though they had been there, but need to return.
