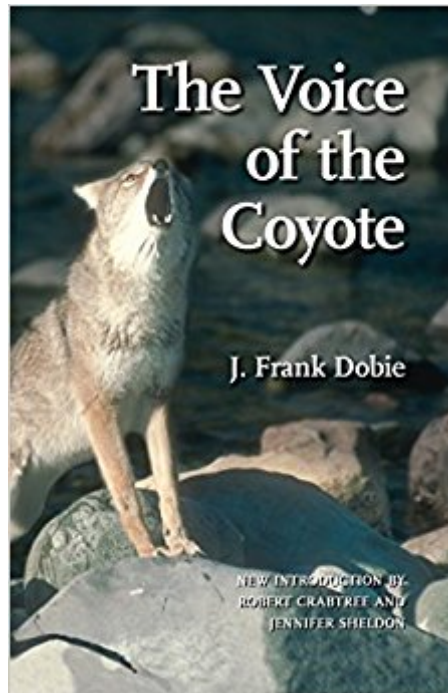




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# The Voice Of The Coyote, Second Edition



## Synopsis

In *The Voice of the Coyote*, J. Frank Dobie melds natural history with tales and lore in articulating the complex and often contentious relationship between coyotes and humans. Based on his own life experiences in Texas and twenty-five years of research, Dobie forges a sympathetic and nuanced picture of the coyote prefiguring later environmental and conservation movements. He recognizes the impact of human action on the coyote while also examining the prominent role of the coyote in the myths and legends of the West.

Robert Crabtree is the founder of the Yellowstone Ecological Research Center. Jennifer Sheldon is a canid biologist and author of *Wild Dogs: Natural History of Non-Domestic Canidae*.

I purchased this book to reference in an art history term paper on Joseph Beuys, for some supplemental insight into the mythos of the coyote... The text is well written and clear, and although this text is decades older than I am, it didn't feel dated at all. The illustrations are lovely, and the cloth cover of this edition of it is particularly handsome. Dobie's *The Voice of the Coyote* is a great read, I'd highly recommend it for coyote nerds like myself.

For those who want to learn more about North America's most intelligent animal, the coyote, this is a renowned source. It is written for the average reader and you don't have to be a scientist to understand it. Coyotes have been unjustly maligned by the special interests of agriculture and hunters. However, these books are based on science and observation, not on myth and the pursuit of profit. I'd also highly recommend *God's Dog* by Hope Ryden, *God's Dog: A Celebration of the North American Coyote* and *Eastern Coyote* by Gerry Parker, *Eastern Coyote* as well as *The Daily Coyote*, *The Daily Coyote: A Story of Love, Survival, and Trust in the Wilds of Wyoming* and Barbara Kingsolver's masterpiece of fiction, *Prodigal Summer*, *Prodigal Summer: A Novel*.
