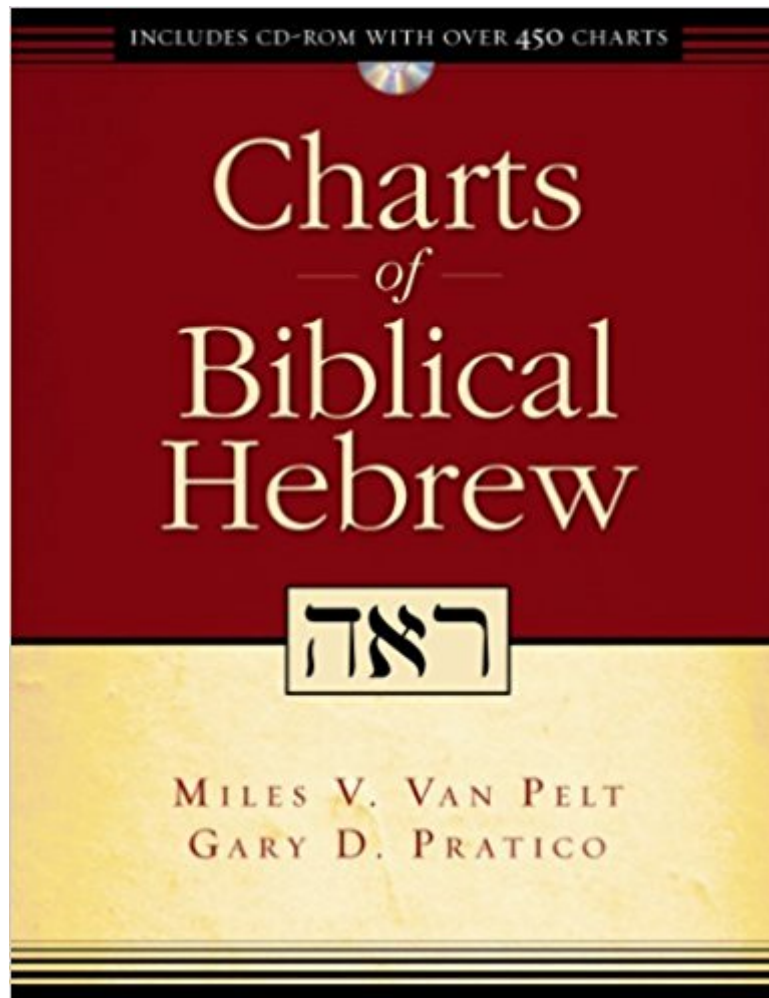

He has been teaching Hebrew for more than thirty years and is coauthor with Miles V. Van Pelt of Basics of Basics of

Biblical Hebrew (grammar and workbook) and The Vocabulary Guide to Biblical Hebrew.

I use this book frequently in my studies. It's quite complete with every possible quick reference chart pertaining to Biblical Hebrew you might ever need. The only part I'm not a fan of is the conjugation order (e.g., 3ms, 2fs, 2ms, 2fs, 1cs, 3mp, etc). Since I'm learning with the Israel Institute of Biblical Studies (the online entity of the Hebrew University of Jerusalem), and they order the conjugations per normal English standards (e.g., 1cs, 2ms, 3ms, etc), it's a struggle to switch paradigms when I reference this book.
