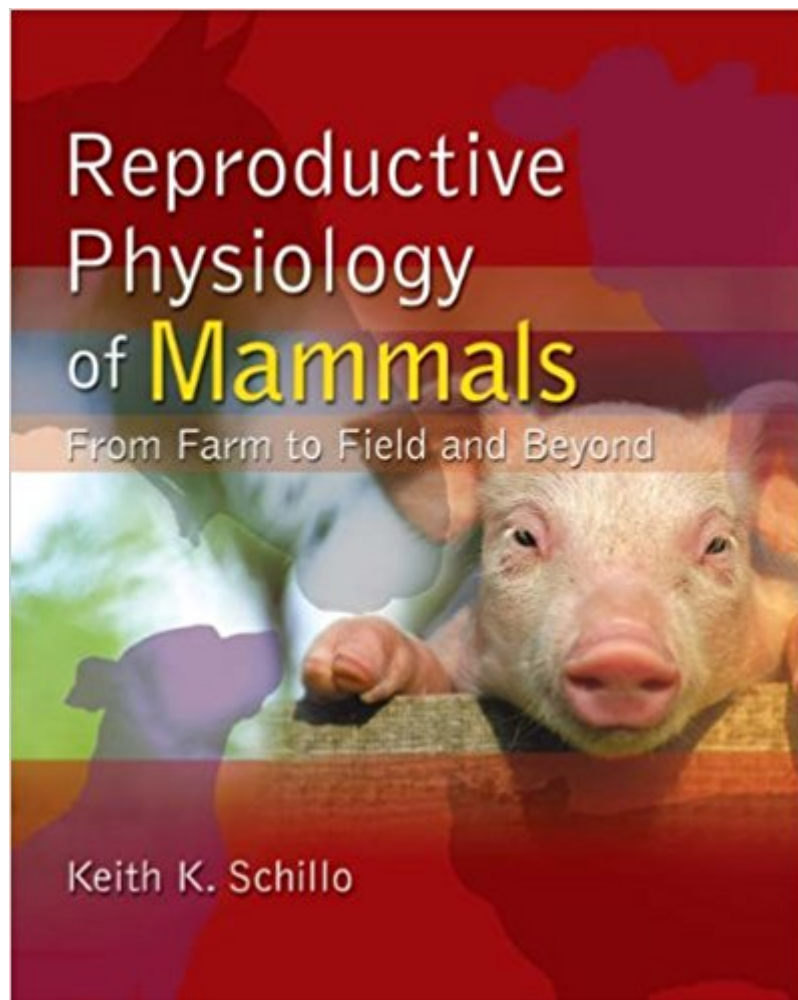




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Reproductive Physiology Of Mammals: From Farm To Field And Beyond

Reproductive Physiology of Mammals: From Farm to Field and Beyond explores the fundamental principles of mammalian reproductive biology in the context of a society that values the management of the reproductive activity of human and nonhuman animals. The format of the book is compatible with traditional approaches to teaching courses in reproductive physiology, but emphasizes basic biological principles and comparative analyses of reproductive physiology. This departure from tradition is intended to accommodate students' growing interests in companion and wild animals and provide expertise that allows students to pursue careers that require literacy in basic science.

Dr. Schillo received a B.S. degree in Animal Science from Cornell University in 1975. For the past 23 years Dr. Schillo has directed a research program dealing with hormonal control of reproduction in cattle and sheep. He has taught reproductive physiology for the past 14 years and now devotes most of his time to teaching. Dr. Schillo is the author of over 50 journal articles and book chapters on topics ranging from reproductive endocrinology to agricultural ethics. He has been invited to speak at numerous conferences and institutions about his research, views on agricultural education and ethical issues in animal science.

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
