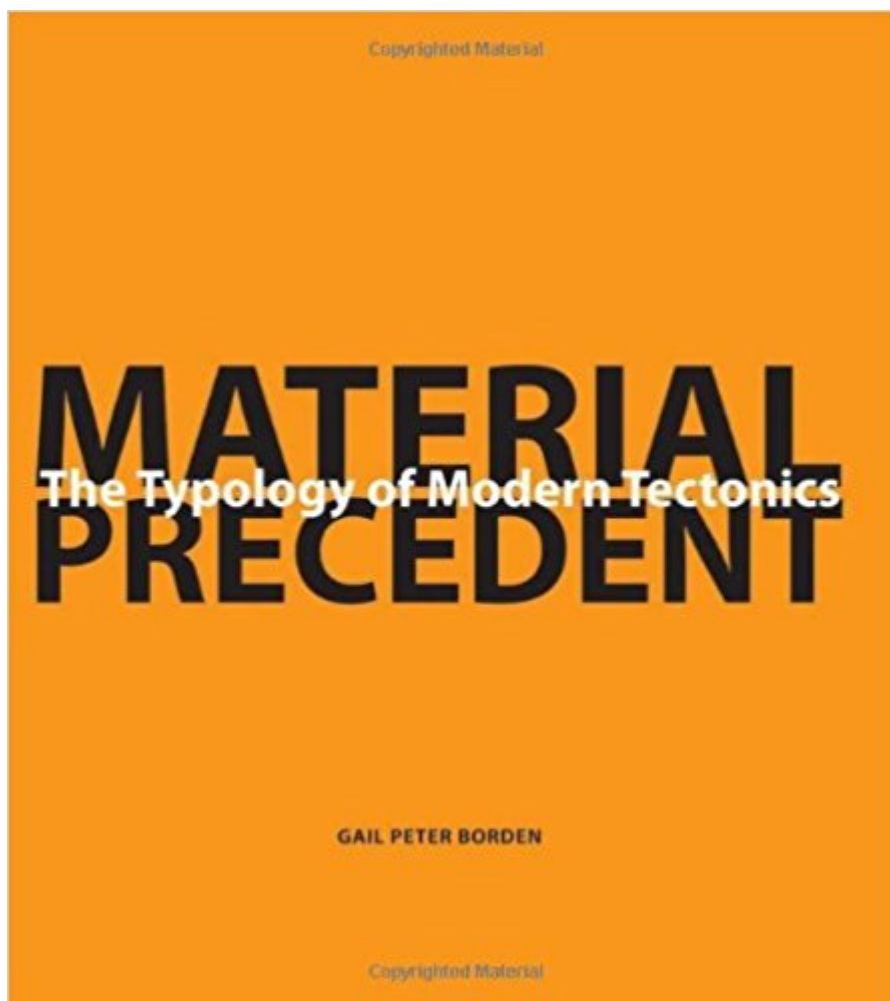




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Gail Peter Borden is Assistant Professor at the University of Southern California (USC) School of
