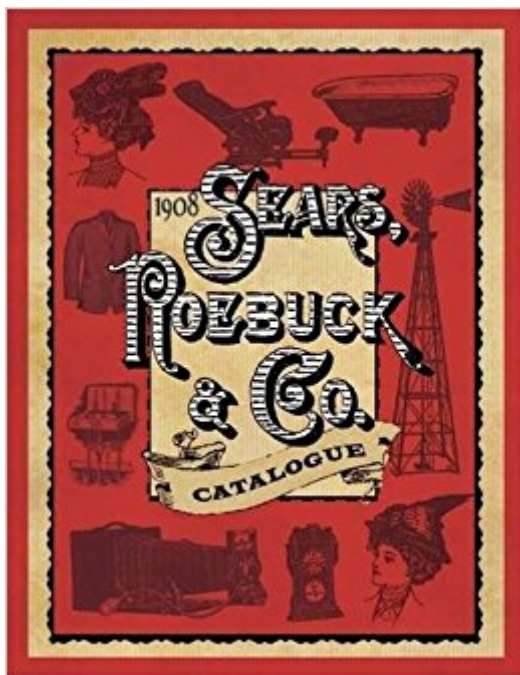

Sears, Roebuck & Co. was founded in 1886 in Chicago, Illinois. It published a general merchandise mail order catalog and consumer guide from 1888 until 1993. It is the author of the 1897 Sears Roebuck & Co. Catalogue and the 1908 Sears, Roebuck & Co. Catalogue.

This is the same reprint that came out about 40 years ago, except this version is very 'murky' - as if it's a multi-generational copy. The different cover fooled me into thinking it wouldn't be heavily edited, but it's missing the same hundreds of pages & is even harder to read than the 'original' reprint of the 1970s. I'd recommend avoiding this book.

This catalogue is GREAT! I would give it a perfect rating if the cover wasn't so glossy and modern looking. A cardboard-paperback cover circa 1900 would be more appropriate.

A fun look at life 100+ years ago! The book was certainly not expensive and worth every penny. Sears carried everything from matches to buggies to pre-fab homes that came complete in kits.
