

This was a good, quick, fun adventure ride. I enjoyed seeing the natural, believable development of Daniel and Craig's friendship. The plot hit all the important beats and was a fun journey, even when I was holding my breath. I enjoyed seeing the story come full circle to the end of *Air Awakens*. That was so satisfying. The book was rife with errors, but it did not take much away from it. I lament Tree end of this series as it makes the end of the (known) adventures in this world. I still hold out hope that we'll get to revisit it with stories of Vhalla and Aldrik's children and maybe even the Crescent Continent.

What a great ending to this prequel trilogy. I loved this story about how Craig and Daniel joined the Golden Guard. Bigger surprise to me though was Raylynn. In the series she is always presented as Baldair's significant other. This is the first time I saw a more fierce side to her that would have me understand how Baldair would be so attracted to her and make her defending Baldair, in the end, make even more sense.

I've been waiting for this since this prequel was announced. My favorite Eastern farmer and his dear friend that melted my heart the first time they appeared on page. Wonderfully wraps up the prequels and leads into the main series. I'm tempted to reread *Air Awakens* right now but I'm waiting till school is out. Do yourself a favor and get both series now. They are wonderful and Kova's world is so captivating.

I've always been interested to know how the bromance between Daniel and Craig came about so I was quite looking forward to this book! From hating each other to being loyal and friends, quite similar to how Baldair and Raylynn relationship first formed. A few spelling mistakes that put me off while reading so docked a star. After finishing this prequel trilogy, I really want to re-read *Air Awakens* but I don't think my heart is ready for a re-brake!

And once again you never cease to amaze me. Your words are so eloquently written that I have a hard time to stopping my reading once I've started at least I remembered that Daniel and Craig were part of the golden guard because I had forgotten and nice job stitching this book to the main
