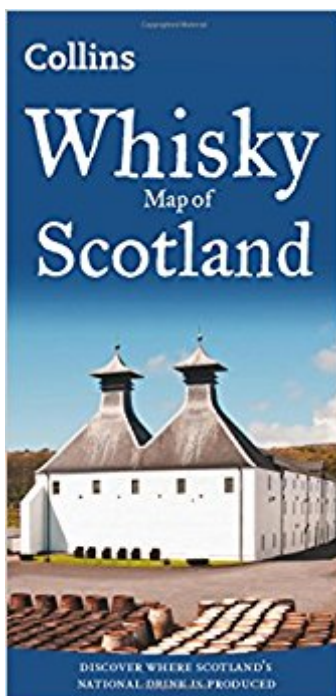

Great map and was helpful, although I think we could have gotten this info without buying it. As distilleries are changing all the time some were not listed on this map. Nice and convenient to see where the distilleries are around the country so we're glad we had it for our trip.

Although the dimensions of the map were large, the actual mapped area of Scotland was shrunk so

that brand images of blended whisky and photos of the distillation process could be printed on the map side. The map is ok, but didn't meet my needs.
